


## Upper Prep (Year 6 - Year 8)



#### Educational and Emotional Support

Our form teachers are supported by a team of classroom support staff and The Durlston Lighthouse is a dedicated department that provides enhanced teaching, learning, and pastoral support. We are committed to help every child navigate their own learning journey and we nurture their social and emotional well-being. The primary goal of the Lighthouse is to ensure that all children, regardless of their abilities or needs, feel integrated into the Durlston Family. We offer guidance, support and a safe haven whenever it is needed, alongside the assistance required to thrive academically and personally. Our qualified Directors of SEND would be more than happy to chat with you during your visit.

#### Minibus Service

We run a fleet of minibuses with flexible routes across the forest and surrounding areas. Additionally, we are able to collect children from New Milton train station – enabling older children to join us from Southampton, Bournemouth, Poole and surrounding areas near a train station.

#### Catering

All food is freshly prepared each day in our school kitchen accommodating any dietary requirements. A daily lunch special is available in addition to the menu options. We provide a mid-morning snack and an afternoon snack for those staying for clubs.

## Our admissions process

#### Visit

We would be delighted to invite you for a tour of the school – giving you the chance to see the school in action and speak with staff and children. There is no need to wait for a formal Open Day, we are happy to arrange visit appointments at a time that is convenient for your family. Children are always welcome to join you for a tour too.

#### Taster Day

If you would then like to explore further the possibility of joining us we invite your child to attend a 'taster day'. We ask all children looking to join us at Year 7 and above to undertake a short, informal assessment. As a non-selective school, this is simply to see what level your child is working at and is certainly not something to worry about. We will be on hand to help. At this point we would ask you to submit a completed registration form, along with a registration fee.

## Offer and acceptance

The next step would be to accept an offer of a place which requires a deposit.

#### Joining

Prior to starting, we will keep in touch with joining information, opportunities to come along to family events and dates for familiarisation sessions for your child. We are on hand every step of the way and always happy to help answer any questions that you or your child might have.
